

Promotion of Students in Grades 1-8

Students in grades 1-8 may be promoted to the next grade level if the following conditions have been satisfied:

The student must have maintained a yearly average of 60% in core classes (Communication Arts, Mathematics, Social Studies, and Science).

The student must have attended at least 90% of classes throughout the year.

For 2nd grade only - In addition to above conditions, the student must score in both Reading and Mathematics NWEA MAP Spring or Summer testing at or above the 30th percentile. If a student satisfies attendance and yearly average conditions, but fails to satisfy NWEA MAP requirement, Grade Placement Committee (GPC) will make a decision. GPC shall be composed of the Principal, Asst. Principal and student's teacher. A decision to promote a student to the next grade level must be unanimous.

The school may offer summer school for class recovery to students failing core subjects and for students that do not meet the 90% attendance requirement. If a failing student does not attend summer school, the student will automatically be retained.
